



2017 Training Program Cardiographic Technician

Certified Cardiographic Technicians are allied health professionals who are trained to perform various diagnostic procedures as directed by a physician. The results of these procedures are used in the evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of patients suffering from cardiac diseases. Cardiographic Technicians are also sometimes referred to as Cardiology or Cardiac Technicians, as well as EKG Technicians. This program teaches how to monitor EKG machines and interpret EKG/ECG readouts, the curriculum includes training in Holter monitoring and stress testing. This comprehensive 60 hour course begins with 12 hours of eLearning combined with 48 classroom hours taught over 3 consecutive Saturday/Sunday weekends. Through a combination of classroom instruction and hands-on training, students will be provided with the knowledge and practical experience needed to enter this high-growth field.

Upon successful completion of the course students will receive a Certification as a Cardiographic Technician. As an option, students desiring to become a National Certified Cardiographic Technician (CCT) can take the test, if qualified, offered by the Cardiovascular Credentialing International Registry (CCI). Eligibility requirements for the CCT exam are determined solely by CCI. AMTI's program has been approved by the Arizona State Board for Private Postsecondary Education as well as CCI, the premier international credentialing organization for the Cardiovascular Technology professions.

Course Tuition is **\$800.00** and includes all textbooks/lab materials. At the time of registration, students can pay the tuition in full, apply for a MACU Education Loan, or utilize a 2-payment approach in meeting the tuition requirements.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITES:

Copy of High School Diploma, G.E.D., College Grade Report, or AMTI Interview.

Students must read/sign Voluntary Assumption of Risk.

COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS:

Complete 12 eLearning hours and 48 classroom hours.

Score 80% or higher on classroom exams, 80% or higher on skill assessments, and 80% or higher on the course final exam.

Optional: Pass the CCI National Certification exam. *Highly Recommended.*

OTHER FEES:

Optional: CCI National Certification exam leading to a CCT (CCI) designation = \$160.00.

REGISTRATION:

Students must complete and sign the CCT Enrollment Agreement as well as read and sign an acknowledgement of having read the 2017 AMTI Student Handbook/Catalogue.

Student admissions are based on a first registration basis until the class is filled. Once filled, a "Class Waiting List" is available for students who desire to be placed on same. To be placed on the waiting list, students must be fully enrolled in a future class.
