## 2017 Training Program

# Certified or Licensed Nursing Assistant

The Nursing Assistant Training Program taught at the Arizona Medical Training Institute is a 120 hour course with class options during the day, evening or weekends. It prepares students to take the Arizona Board of Nursing exam and upon passing the candidate will be entered into the registry as a Certified Nursing Assistant or Licensed Nursing Assistant. Nursing Assistants can find employment in long-term care facilities, home health agencies, hospitals and hospice organizations where basic bedside nursing care is needed.

Classroom instruction includes an introduction to health care, basic nursing skills, body structure and function, infection control, CPR and the job-seeking process. Students participate in clinical activities under the supervision of the RN instructor in both the skills lab and clinical facilities. The program has been approved by the State Board of Nursing and is the largest program in Arizona, testing 800 first-time candidates in 2016.

CNA Course Tuition is **\$1,155.00** payable at the time of registration. Students can pay the tuition in full, apply for a MACU Education Loan, or utilize a 2-payment, 3-payment or 6-payment plan. Tuition includes all textbooks, lab materials, Healthcare Provider level CPR and TB Test (by serum), fingerprinting, gait belt, uniform top, blood pressure cuff and stethoscope.

### PROGRAM PREREQUISITIES:

Pass a nursing board mandated CNA admissions test covering reading, reading comprehension, and math.

No active Felony (ARS 32-1606) in the past 5 years or Unprofessional Conduct (ARS 32-1601)

Completed Health Declaration that you can complete all essential functions

Proof of Citizenship (Arizona Drivers License, U.S. Birth Certificate or U.S. Passport) or legal residency status.

Students must sign a voluntary assumptions of risk and student rights and responsibilities.

Students must be TB free and be able to pass a TB test or provide prior results no older than 6 months from testing.

### COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS:

Complete 80 classroom and 40 clinical hours

Score 80% or higher on classroom exams, 80% or higher on clinical grades, and 80% or higher on the course final written exam and final skill demonstration.

### OTHER FEES:

Clinical orientation fee = \$10.00 payable during classroom phase

Arizona State Written Final Exam through D&S Diversified Technology = \$118.00

Licensed Nursing Assistant Fee = \$100 payable to the Arizona State Board of Nursing

### REGISTRATION:

Students can register in person, online at [www.azmti.com](http://www.azmti.com), or by phone.

Students must complete and sign the NA Enrollment Agreement, read and sign an acknowledgement of having read the 2017 AMTI Student Handbook/Catalogue as well as the documents noted under "Program Prerequisites."

Student admissions are based on a first registration basis until the class is filled. Once filled, a "Class Waiting List" is available for students who desire to be placed on same. To be placed on the waiting list, students must be fully enrolled in a future class.
