



2017 Training Program MLA + Phlebotomy Module

The MLA Program with Phlebotomy Training is for the student who desires a position as an MLA (CLA) but does not possess formal, verifiable Phlebotomy training or experience. The Phlebotomy Training Module is geared to provide the essential training to safely perform a variety of specimen collections that an MLA will be required to perform in the healthcare setting.

This training will not lead to certification as a Phlebotomy Technician. Students desiring American Society of Clinical Pathology or American Medical Technologist Certification should select the Phlebotomy Technician Program. The Phlebotomy Training Module is an eLearning approach combined with classroom instruction. The eLearning portion will require 10 hours of online instruction completed prior to and during the classroom phase. The classroom phase, consistent with the MLA Program will occur on three (3) consecutive Saturday/Sunday weekends from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Students desiring to transition to the MLA Program must successfully complete the Phlebotomy Training Module prior to their MLA Program start date. Students will not receive a separate Certification upon successful completion of the Module. However, upon successful completion of the MLA Program, for those students who have completed the Module, recognition of such will be included on the MLA Certification.

Tuition for the MLA Program + Phlebotomy Module is **\$2,300.00**. Tuition includes all textbooks, lab materials, uniform top and all supplies. Students will incur the cost of immunizations if not up to date. At the time of registration, tuition can be paid in full, apply for a MACU Education Loan, or a 2-payment, 3-payment or 6-payment approach is also available.

PROGRAM PREREQUISITIES:

- Copy of High School Diploma, G.E.D., College Grade Report
- Completed Health Declaration that you can complete all essential functions & all required immunizations.
- Current CPR at Health Care Provider level & First Aid.
- Students must read/sign Safety and Infection Control Policy & Voluntary Assumption of Risk, HIPPA Confidentiality Policy, Laboratory Rules and Externship Agreement.
- Students must be willing to submit to a drug test and/or criminal background check, if requested.

COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete 100 eLearning hours, plus 144 classroom hours and 120 clinical hours. Total of 364 hours.
- Score 80% or higher on classroom exams, clinical performance, and 80% or higher on the course final exam.

OTHER FEES:

- Clinical orientation fee = \$20.00 payable during classroom phase
- Optional: AMT national certification exam leading to a CMLA (AMT) designation = \$ 95.00.

REGISTRATION:

- Students can register in-person, on-line at www.azmti.com, or by phone.
- Students must complete and sign the MLA Enrollment Agreement, read and sign an acknowledgement of having read the 2017 AMTI Student Handbook/Catalogue as well as the documents noted under "Program Prerequisites."
- Student admissions are based on a first registration basis until the class is filled. Once filled, a "Class Waiting List" is available for students who desire to be placed on same. To be placed on the waiting list, students must be fully enrolled in a future class.

Students must provide proof of immunizations and medical clearance certifying that all essential functions can be performed as reviewed by a medical doctor.

Complete 10 hours of eLearning in AMTI's eClassroom (www.azmti.com/eclasses) prior to the Classroom dates. The Classroom schedule is Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM for 3 weekends. During the classroom phase, students will complete 48 hours of basic phlebotomy skills. At the completion of the Phlebotomy Module, students will have 1 to 2 weeks before beginning the MLA Classroom phase of the program. Please call the school if you miss the enrollment period for the Phlebotomy Module to review other options on completing the phlebotomy component.

Complete 30 hours of eLearning in AMTI's eClassroom (www.azmti.com/eclasses) prior to the classroom dates. The classroom schedule is Saturday & Sunday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM for 6 weekends. During the classroom phase students will complete 10 hours of eLearning per week. After the classroom phase, students must complete an assigned externship meeting a minimum of 120 hours at a CLIA approved lab. If you wish to still enroll after the last date indicated of the eLearning period you must call the school to ensure you have adequate time to complete the eLearning requirement.
