## 2018 Training Program Certified or Licensed Nursing Assistant

The Nursing Assistant Training Program taught at the Arizona Medical Training Institute is a 125-hour course with class options during the day, evening or weekends. It prepares students to take the Arizona Board of Nursing exam and upon passing the candidate will be entered into the registry as a Certified Nursing Assistant or Licensed Nursing Assistant. Nursing Assistants can find employment in long-term care facilities, home health agencies, hospitals and hospice organizations where basic bedside nursing care is needed.

Classroom instruction includes an introduction to health care, basic nursing skills, body structure and function, infection control, CPR and the job-seeking process. Students participate in clinical activities under the supervision of the RN instructor in both the skills lab and clinical facilities. The program has been approved by the State Board of Nursing and is the largest program in Arizona, testing 600 first-time candidates in 2017.

CNA Program Cost is **\$1,355.00** payable at the time of registration. Students, at the time of registration, can pay the tuition in full, apply for a MACU educational loan, or utilize a 2, 3 or 6-payment approach. Price includes all textbooks, lab materials, Healthcare Provider level CPR and TB Test (by serum), fingerprinting, gait belt, uniform top, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, technology fee and clinical orientation fee.

### PROGRAM PREREQUISITES:

Pass a nursing board mandated CNA admissions test covering reading, reading comprehension, and math.

No active Felony (ARS 32-1606) in the past 5 years or Unprofessional Conduct (ARS 32-1601)

Completed Health Declaration that you can complete all essential functions.

Proof of Citizenship (Arizona Drivers License, U.S. Birth Certificate or U.S. Passport) or legal residency status.

Students must sign a voluntary assumption of risk and student rights and responsibilities.

Students must demonstrate TB clearance or provide prior results no older than 6 months from testing.

### COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS:

Complete 80 classroom and 45 clinical hours

Score 80% or higher on classroom exams, 80% or higher on clinical grades, and 80% or higher on the course final written exam and final skill demonstration.

### OTHER FEES:

3-month payment plan requires \$30 finance fee and \$25 setup fee. 6-month plan is \$30 finance fee and \$45 setup fee. Setup fees are paid to Nelnet/eCashier.

Arizona State Written Final Exam through D&S Diversified Technology = \$118.00

Licensed Nursing Assistant Fee = \$100 payable to the Arizona State Board of Nursing
