

The Program

The Nursing Assistant Program, as approved by the Arizona State Board of Nursing, is a 120-hour program comprised of 80 classroom/laboratory hours and 40 clinical hours. This program will provide students with the theory and skills required to practice as a certified nursing assistant in long-term care, intermediate care, and acute care settings.

The curriculum includes classroom, lab and clinical instruction covering basic psychological and physiological nursing methods used throughout the life of a client, with a primary focus on long term care. Teaching methods encompass a variety of strategies including hands on practice, discussion, videos, e-learning, as well as laboratory and clinic based work experience.

Students will learn about the Nursing Assistant's role, foundation of resident care, understanding resident and family needs, anatomy and physiology, personal care skills, basic nursing skills, nutrition and hydration, chronic and acute conditions, and rehabilitation and restorative services.
