

The Program

The Phlebotomy Program begins with the eLearning portion that must be completed prior to the start of the on-campus classroom session. The classroom component entails five weeks of class. Upon completion, the clinical practicum must be fulfilled at an AMTI assigned facility and on a schedule required by the site. Students must complete a minimum of 100 hours of clinical practicum and 120 unaided collections to formally graduate.

The Phlebotomy Technician Program at the Arizona Medical Training Institute prepares students for entry level competencies as phlebotomists in hospitals, clinics, blood donor centers, and other health care settings.

National Certification for qualified students can be achieved by passing an optional American Society for Clinical Pathology Exam for \$125.00, earning the title of PBT (ASCP).
